



## Dragon puppet.

You will need:


Cardboard tube, Thick cardboard, Coloured paper/card, Glue, Scissors, Sellotape, String, Pencil and Paint brush, Template




To start cut your cardboard tube in to two pieces and them paint. Set to one side to dry.



Next use the template to draw around on coloured paper then cut out, make a fold on the flat edge of the wing about 1cm wide. Cut out a triangle piece of card this will make your dragons tail.




You will now need to cut strips of coloured paper/card to make the legs and neck. Cut strips about 1.5cm wide and the full length of an A4 piece of paper.




To make the legs take two strips and glue one corner to the other, now fold the strip across the top of the other then fold the other strip one that one continue doing this until you get to the end of the strip and then glue in place to stop unfolding. You need to make 5 of these.



Cut out 4 feet from the template or draw your own, then stick your foot to the bottom of your folded leg. You need to Make 4 of these.



Now you need to make the head, to do this take the small part of the painted tube and push one side together and fix with Sellotape, cut out a fire shape from orange card and some eyes and stick to your dragon's head. Carefully put a small hole in the top of the head using a pencil this will be to put your string through.




Take the longer painted tube, using Sellotape stick your wings on evenly either side.



Once you have your wings in place, stick the triangle you cut out earlier the bottom end of your paper tube. You will now need to put a hole using a pencil just above the tail and one in the middle of each wing.



Turn your dragon over and attached the wobbly legs you made earlier.




Use the other folded strip to attach the head to the body, I used Sellotape to help hold it in place. Set to one side.



Cut 2 strips of card 3cm x 25cm glue together in a cross shape. Using a pencil put a hole in the end of each strip.



Cut 4 pieces of string about 30cm long, thread one piece of string through each of the holes and tie a knot in the top to stop in sliding through.



Thread one of the pieces of string through the hole near the dragons tail and tie a knot, thread the opposite piece of string through the dragon head until the neck is stretched, then tie a knot and cut off the excess string.



Thread the other two pieces of string through the holes in the wings tie a knot.

You now have your very own dragon puppet.
