

YARN CHRISTMAS STAR

You will need:

Cardboard, star template available on Cheshire Museums website, different coloured yarn/wool, scissors, Sellotape

Instructions:

1/ Print off the template of the star and use it to cut out a star shape in sturdy cardboard.



2/ Sellotape one end of the wool/yarn to the back of the star and begin to wrap the yarn around the star, using all the different corners - keep going until the whole star is covered in wool/yarn. I used different colours of wool, and just tied them together and made sure the joins were on the back of the star. You may wish to put a little bit of glue on the end of the star points just to secure the yarn there, although it is your choice.

3/ When wrapping the yarn/wool around the star, use all the corners to wrap it around in order that the wool remains as secure and tight as possible.



4/ Tuck the end of the yarn onto the back of the cardboard and use a little piece of Sellotape to secure it there.

5/ Attach another loop of yarn to hang your beautiful yarn Christmas star on the tree or just on your mantlepiece.
