

Fabric tray.

You will need: 2 x fabric squares 21cmx21cm, scissors, sewing thread, chalk and pins.



Cut out 2 fabric squares place on top of each other with the front of the fabrics facing each other, pin in place.



Sew around 1cm around the edge leaving a small gap 3-4cm at the top, trim of the corners. Now turn inside out by pushing the fabric through the small opening at the top.



Using chalk mark out a square on the lining 3cm in from the edge, then sew around the square and wipe off chalk.



Place a pin 3cm from each corner fold the fabric over so that the two pins on each corner line up and then replace the two pins with one. Sew a straight line down where the pin held the corners together repeat for all 4 corners.



Open up tray now push each corner flat and hand sew in place.



Your tray is now ready to use for trinkets, sewing items, jewellery or what ever you want to place in.
