


LADYBIRD CRAFT

You will need:


- black card
- red card
- green paper
- coloured pencils/pens
- glue stick
- scissors
- googly eyes
- black paint

How to make your Ladybirds:


1. Cut out 4 x 10cm wide circles in black card, 4 x 10cm wide circles in red card, and 4 x 5cm wide circles in black card.



2. Using black paint (or a black felt-tip pen), dab spots onto the red card circles. Let the paint dry thoroughly.



3. Take some A3 sized green paper (or some white paper and colour it in green), fold it in half and then cut out of one side the shape of a leaf (or any shape you wish).



4. Use pens/pencils to draw veins onto these leaves.



5. Glue the leaves together to create a clump, and then glue the larger black card circles onto these leaves. These are the bodies of the ladybirds.



6. Next glue the smaller black circles onto the edges of these larger black circles - these are the ladybird's head. Then glue googly eyes onto the ladybird's heads - I did it so they were all looking in different directions to make it more interesting.



7. To create antennae, simply cut thin strips of black card, then fold twice so that there are two parts which stick up and a flat base part in the middle.



8. Spread glue onto flat base and stick onto the ladybird's heads just behind the eyes. Let the glue dry thoroughly.



9. Finally, you need to create the ladybird's wings - to do this you simply cut the red circles in half, then bend back a small part at the top of the wing.



10. Put glue on the underside of this small part then glue both sides down to give the impression that the ladybird is about to fly away!



Your ladybirds are now complete!
