

OLYMPIC STADIUM CRAFT

You will need:

- thin card
- paints and coloured pencils or crayons
- sellotape or a stapler

How to make your Olympic Stadium:

1. Print out the Olympic Stadium template from the West Cheshire Museums website.

2. You can then use this template to cut out the two sloping sides of the stadium - I cut out the two shapes in thin card but if you haven't got any card then paper is fine.

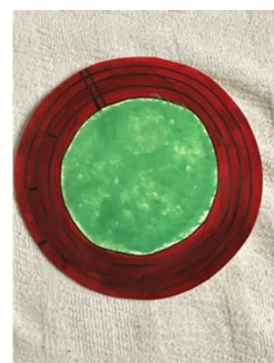


3. Next add the crowd to the stadium using finger printing - use flesh colours for the faces and then add different colours for the body. If you wish, you can add hair using either paint or coloured pencils. Leave to dry.



4. Next cut a circle out of card or paper, approximately 18cm in diameter (this is about the size of a small paper plate).

5. This will be the track and field space at the bottom of the stadium - paint/colour the track round the edge of the circle (I used a red/brown colour but grey is also ok). If you wish you can draw in the individual lanes but this is not necessary. Then paint/colour the grass in the middle of the circle - leave to dry.



6. When the paint is dry, join the two sides of the stadium making sure it fits around the edge of the bottom circle. You could join them using sellotape or with a stapler.



7. You may wish to decorate the outside of the stadium with the Olympic Rings symbol or perhaps another pattern/design of your choice. You can even add the girders to the inside of the stadium – again it's your choice.



Your Olympic Stadium is now complete!
