

WOOLLY YARN LAMB

You will need:

- lamb template (from the West Cheshire Museums website)
- white card
- Sellotape
- scissors
- glue
- a small plate
- white/cream-coloured wool (as thick as possible)

How to make your woolly lamb:

1. Draw round a small plate (around 20cm diameter) onto white card then cut out the circle.



2. Use the scissors to cut out small notches around the circle.



3. Sellotape one end of the wool to the back of the cardboard circle and begin to wind the wool round all the notches, using lots of angles, to cover the front of the cardboard circle with wool. This part of the craft is very good for developing young children's fine motor skills.



4. Print off the lamb template and cut out the head and legs of the lamb. If you have enough cardboard left over from drawing the circle then you could use that.



5. Stick the head onto the front of the plate and then add the four legs - see photo.



You now have a lovely woolly yarn lamb - you could attach an extra piece of wool and make it into a hanging! Have fun!
