

MR OR MRS EARTH

You will need:

- A completed Earth Day Handprint Art Piece (instructions are available on the West Cheshire Museums website)
- green card
- scissors
- Sellotape
- glue
- black felt tip pen

How to make your Mr or Mrs Earth

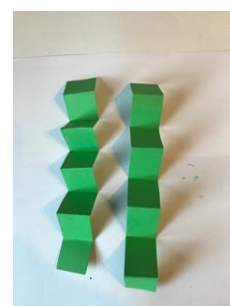
1. Place the bowl over your Earth Day Handprint Art Piece, draw a pencil line around it. Cut out the handprinted Earth.



2. Take your green piece of card and measure out three 3cm width strips - these can be the whole length of the piece of card. Cut them out.



3. Take the first two strips of green card and fold concertina style down their whole length - see photo. Take the third strip of card and cut it exactly in half to give you two shorter strips of card. Fold both of these shorter strips of card concertina style down their whole length.



4. Stick the two longer pieces onto the bottom end of the handprinted Earth - these are the legs. Stick the two shorter pieces on each side to be the arms. Using your imagination, draw some eyes and a mouth, colour them and cut out - stick them onto Mr or Mrs Earth's 'face'.



You can either stick your creation up on the wall as decoration, or perhaps even stick it onto your window to remind people about Earth Day on 22 April.
