

FOIL FISH CRAFT

You will need:

- cardboard
- silver foil
- glue
- oil pastels if possible, but wax crayons will work too
- optional: rainbow fish template from the West Cheshire Museums website

How to make your foil fish craft:

1. Cut a fish shape out of cardboard - you could use the rainbow fish template on the West Cheshire Museums website, or draw your own fish.



2. Cover one side of the fish in glue and stick it onto the foil.



3. Now cover the other side of the fish in glue then wrap the foil around the fish, making sure all of it is covered - smooth out the foil so it is as flat as possible.



- Using oil pastels (or wax crayons), draw different shapes and patterns in many colours onto the foil - the brighter the better! Circles, scales, stripes, curvy lines - any of them look great!
