

## PAPER PLATE JELLYFISH CRAFT

### You will need:

- 2 x small paper plates (or cardboard circles)
- paints
- silver foil
- stapler
- paper and black felt-tip pen
- translucent confetti or glitter (optional)

### How to make your paper plate jellyfish:

1. Take a paper plate (or cardboard circle) and draw a curvy line across it about two-thirds of the way down. Cut along this line. Repeat with the other paper plate or cardboard circle.



2. Paint each paper plate on one side - I used pastel shades which I thought made the jellyfish more translucent, but you choose which colours you think look best.



3. Let the paint dry then stick the two plates together using the stapler, but leave the bottom curvy edge unstapled.
4. Tear/cut long strips of silver foil and glue them between the two (curvy) bottom edges - use staples to secure them.
5. Draw a couple of eyes on white paper, cut out and stick them onto the jellyfish head.
6. As finishing touch, you could add glue onto the jellyfish head and sprinkle with translucent confetti. Alternatively, glitter would also create a lovely effect.
